

SHOOTING SPORTS PERMISSION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT SLIP

The Shooting Sports Committee, GNYC, will be conducting a shooting sports weekend / program. In this program, Scouts will shoot Archery, BB guns, rifles, and / or shotguns under the supervision of an NRA Range Safety Officer and NRA certified instructors or Archery instructor and or BSA Range Masters. Scouts will be required to wear eye protection and hearing protection at all times while on the range. Scouts are expected to abide by all safety rules and the instructions of all range personnel.

I, the undersigned, give my child, _____, Unit # _____, permission to participate in this program. I understand that participation in the activity involves a certain degree of risk. I have carefully considered the risk involved and have given consent for my child to participate in the activity. I understand that participation in the activity is entirely voluntary and requires participants to abide by the rules and standards of conduct. I release the Boy Scouts of America, the local council, the activity coordinators, and all employees, volunteers, related parties, or other organizations associated with the activity from any and all claims or liability arising out of this participation.

1. Attend a range safety briefing.
2. Wear all safety gear at all times while on the range.

4. Follow the instructions of the Range Safety Officer(s) and / or Instructor(s).
5. Do not handle any firearm until instructed to do so by Instructor(s).
